Who should attend: 3rd-6th Grade softball players who have registered for RYS rec softball. Parents are encouraged to attend as well for a brief Introduction of coaches and short Q&A session. **ALL COACHES (HEAD AND ASSISTANT) NEED TO ATTEND!**

Details:

This is the night when coaches select teams in grades 3-6. We set up simple batting and fielding stations for the girls to demonstrate their softball skills (zero skill level required by the way). After skills assessment is complete players are dismissed and the coaches head to the war room to privately draft their teams for the season.
