Nurse Updates

We are taking extra precautions to keep students and staff safe. If your child has one high risk symptom or two or more low risk symptoms we are asking you to keep your child home. If your child has these symptoms at school we will be sending them home and following up with when they can return to school. If your child is experiencing any combination of COVID-19 symptoms please contact your healthcare provider for further instruction. If your child is negative for COVID-19 and has no known exposure AND has symptom improvement they can return with a negative COVID test and a doctor's note. If you would like to monitor symptoms at home your child must stay home for 10 days from the onset of symptoms.

If your doctor diagnoses your child with another illness and does not believe they need to be tested for COVID-19 please have them write a note, let the school know and send it with your child.
