Point totals for the ratings included 81 - 100 = division 1, 61 - 80 = division 2, and 60 or lower = division 3. R-S scores were 93, 97, and 93 for a total of 283 out of 300 points. Outstanding soloists included: Noah Britten - alto saxophone, Macy Friest - trumpet, Jacob Hennager - guitar, and Xander Webb - drum set. Two hundred eighty-three points is the most total points R-S has ever had in any jazz festival in March or April. Congrats to everyone for doing an awesome job!
